This painting depicts the DISCOVER-AQ mission concept. DISCOVER-AQ is a four-year campaign that will improve the use of satellites to monitor air quality for public health and environmental benefit. The mission began in 2011 with targeted airborne and ground-based observations and will continue through 2014. Improved diagnosis of conditions from space promises better strategies for managing and reducing the factors contributing to poor air quality.
